Dress Code & Class Policies

Attire:

Please note that appropriate attire is mandatory while attending sessions.

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

- ✓ NO hats, scarves, etc., of any kind.
- ✓ NO shorts or short skirts/dresses.
- ✓ NO tattered, torn, or holes on T-shirts and/or tops,
- ✓ NO tank tops, low cut or half shirts of any kind.
- ✓ NO foul or offensive language of any kind on apparel or shoes.

Appropriate make-up will be worn as well. If these rules are not followed the student will be removed from the class.

Conduct:

We expect all participants attending classes to be respectful and absolutely NO foul or abusive language will be tolerated at anytime during these sessions. NO abusive behavior of any kind will be tolerated and this will be an automatic failure of the class. Please be respectful to staff at all times and we ask that you utilize the information provided to you.

Electronics:

There are NO electronic devices allowed by any student or parent at class. All cell phones, MP3 players, texting devices, and any other mechanical/electronic devices are to be left at home or they will be confiscated until you leave.

Attendance:

We require Prompt arrival to classes. The doors will be locked to any late arrivals.
